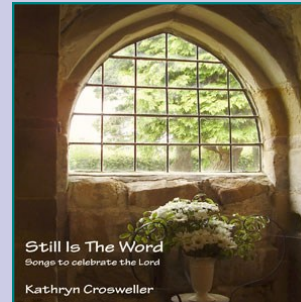

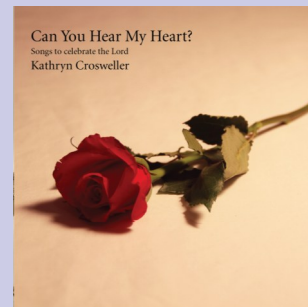

Kathryn's first album contains some of her favourite songs from many areas of Christianity and one original song. 'Grant Me Humility' is inspired by the teachings of St. Francis of Assisi, for whom humility was one of the most important characteristics to develop, and is particularly relevant when following a singing career. Kathryn aims to sing with this principle in mind at all times.



Kathryn's second album contains ecumenical music from a range of Christian traditions, and it also contains several original pieces. The title track, 'Can You Hear My Heart?' is a testament to the sacrifice Jesus made for us and the pain he went through.
